Target Audience: Local Villagers, Community Members & School Students


3. Objectives

The initiative successfully sensitized the rural population about the legal and social consequences of child marriage.

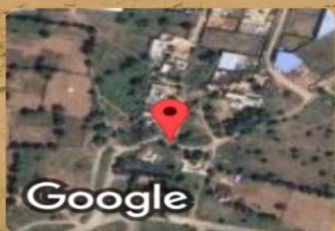
Students developed leadership and communication skills through community engagement.
